Paper Petals by Robert Krampf, The Happy Scientist

Color the flowers with crayons. The wax will help waterproof the paper. Use scissors to cut them out. Use crayons to color the backs of the petals, but do not color the back of the flower's center.

Fold each petal across the center, so the flower is closed up. Then place it in a shallow dish of water. Watch it carefully to see what happens.
